(Section 551.071, Texas Open Meetings Act)
- (b) The purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property, if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the District in negotiations with a third person. (Section 551.072, Texas Open Meetings Act)
- (c) A contract for a prospective gift or donation to the District if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the District in negotiations with a third person. (Section 551.073, Texas Open Meetings Act)
- (d) Personnel matters involving the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint against an officer or employee. (Section 551.074, Texas Open Meetings Act)
- (e) Water system security procedures or devices. (Section 551.076, Texas Open Meetings Act)
- (f) Commercial or financial information that the district has received from a business prospect and to deliberate the offer or other incentives to a business prospect. (Section 551.087, Texas Open Meetings Act)

- (b) The presiding officer will call on registered speakers to comment on each agenda item before the Board takes the matter under consideration. Registered speakers will be called in the order that the Public Participation Form is received.
- (c) Each registered speaker is allowed 3 minutes per agenda item with a total time of 21 minutes allotted for each agenda item. Time spent on Board member questions or comments shall not be counted against a registered speaker's time. Registered speakers may not pool their time or give unused time to another speaker.
- (d) If there are 3 or more individuals aligned on an issue who plan to provide the same or similar comments, the presiding officer may require the group to designate one or more spokespersons to speak on the group's behalf. However, the meeting minutes will include all Public Participation Registration Forms to reflect the total number of individuals aligned on the issue.
- (e) For matters of exceptional interest to the Board, the Board may vote to extend the time allocated to one or more registered speakers and/or the total amount of time allocated for any specific agenda item.
